BLUEBERRY BLONDE ALE, Saranac Brewing Co, Utica, NY ABV 5.0% **6.00**
An traditional blonde ale with a kick of juicy blueberry with a low hop bitterness, which really shows off the fruit. **Beer of the 2024 Chili Feast, Saratoga Springs.**



COLD DAY IPA, Montouk Brewing, Montouk, NY, ABV 6.7% IBU: 22 **7.00**
This Long Island IPA has aroma of pineapple & grapefruit. Mildly sweet with some bitterness. Flavors: tangerine, grapefruit & hops. It's perfect beer to warm the spirit and help remind you that even the freezing days are beautiful ones.



GUINNESS, Irish (Dry) Stout (20oz Glass), Dublin, Ireland, ABV: 4.2% IBU: 45 **7.00**
Originated in the late 18th century. This stout has a malty sweetness & a hoppy bitterness, with notes of coffee & chocolate.



COFFEE CUP STOUT, Common Roots, S. Glen Falls, NY ABV 9.0% **8.00**
Double Coffee Stout infused with Common Roots Coffee Company's house roasted blend. Specialty malts impart rich flavors of chocolate and caramel.



1911 Established, CRANBERRY HARD CIDER, LaFayette, NY ABV 6.9% **7.00**
This is a semi-sweet cider that provides that has unique blend of apples and New England cranberries strikes a delicate balance of sweet and tart.



PERONI NASTRO AZZURRO LAGER, Vigevano, Italy. ABV 5.1% **7.50**

SWITCHBACK ALE, Switchback Brewing Co, Burlington VT ABV 5.0% IBU 28 **7.00**

SAMUEL ADAMS, SEASONAL, Boston, MA. **7.00**
Summer Ale ABV 5.3% IBU 8; October Feast ABV 5.3% IBU 16; White Christmas ABV 5.8 IBU 8; Winter Lager ABV 5.6% IBU 22; Cold Stap ABV 5.3% IBU 7



MILLER LIGHT, Wisconsin. ABV 4.2% **6.00**
The original light beer. Brewed for more taste, this light beer has a light to medium body with a hop forward flavor, solid malt character and a clean finish.



BLUE MOON BELGIAN WHITE ALE, Denver, CO. ABV 5.4% IBU 9 **7.00**
A 1995 classic Belgian Wit recipe and then tweaking it with Valencia orange peel and making a beer unlike any other. A beer with sweetness and citrusy flavor.



FIDDLEHEAD IPA, Fiddlehead Brewing Co., Shelburne, VT. ABV 6.2% IBU 53 **7.00**
Fiddlehead flagship IPA, A hop forward American IPA with mellow bitterness. Citrusy and Dank. Well Balanced.



CHERRY WHEAT ALE, Frog Alley, Schenectady, NY, ABV 5.5% IBU: 8 **8.00**
This ale is full of tangy Montmorency cherries. The light malt sweetness provided by Wheat and Barley malts interacts perfectly with the tartness of the cherries.
